Changing Room Policy

All ECB affiliated cricket clubs must have a Changing Room Policy. Lancing Manor take the safeguarding of players very seriously and therefore abide by the ECB guidelines - as such, children are defined as any players under the age of 18 years. The rules apply to league, T20, friendly matches, alternative format games or training held at Lancing Manor CC.

Please note the following **must be adhered to at all times when the pavilion is in use:**

- Children and adults, regardless of gender or identity, **must not** use the changing room at the same time.
- Female and male players **must not** use the changing room at the same time.
- Use of mobile phones and other camera equipment is **strictly prohibited** in the changing room. Anyone caught using such a device will be removed from the changing room and a report may be submitted to the ECB.
- If children or female players feel uncomfortable using the changing rooms, they will not be forced to do so and can arrive already changed for the game. However, the facilities will always be made available to them.

Important Note: Should any player feel there has been a breach of this policy, they can report it to the club safeguarding officer, or the county safeguarding officer. Details of the safeguarding officials are displayed in the pavilion.
